# C.S.D.I.A.I.

## MEMBERSHIP TYPES

### Active Membership

Persons in law enforcement who are engaged in the forensic sciences and their application to identification and investigation, provided, however, that the foregoing persons are bona fide employees of, and who receive full-time salaries from the National, State, County or Municipal Governments, or some subdivision thereof.

### Associate Membership

All reputable persons wholly or partially engaged in any of the various phases of the science of identification or investigation and who are not qualified for Active Membership are eligible to become Associate Members. They shall in all respects be subject to the same rights and privileges as Active Members except that they shall be eligible to hold only the office of Director.

### Student Membership

All persons enrolled as a student in an accredited college or university, who are majoring in a law enforcement or forensic science related field. Student Members shall in all respects be subject to the same rights and privileges as Active Members, except that they shall not have the right to vote nor be eligible to hold any elected or appointed office of this Association.

- Become part of a group that serves as a focal point to share public information concerning the forensic identification profession.
- Access to the CSDIAI on-line digest. The digest is produced bi-monthly and includes several articles relating to the identification field, including: history, current techniques or procedures and events regarding forensic identification.
